

INSTALLING A LINKS CHAMPIONSHIP COURSE FOR MACINTOSH

Before you begin using your Links Championship Course, make a backup copy of the original disk(s) to work with during installation. For instructions on how to copy disks, refer to your Macintosh documentation.

To install the Links Championship Course:

- 1** Turn off or remove any virus protection software.
- 2** Restart your Macintosh.
- 3** Insert Course Disk 1 and double-click the Course Installer icon. Click OK to continue.
- 4** The Course Installer will search your hard drive(s) for the Links Pro program files. If the Course Installer cannot locate the Links Pro program files it will bring up a dialog box asking you to **SELECT FOLDER** to install all course files or Cancel installation.

- Click **INSTALL** to install everything from all the disks onto your hard drive in the Links Pro folder.

- Click **SELECT NEW FOLDER** to install everything from all the disks onto your hard drive in a folder you choose.

When installation is complete, a message appears indicating that the installation was successful.

- 5** Click OK to exit the Course Installer and return to the Finder.
- 6** Replace or turn on any virus protection software you removed in step 1; restart your Macintosh.

You are ready to start playing your Links Championship Course with Links Pro Macintosh.
