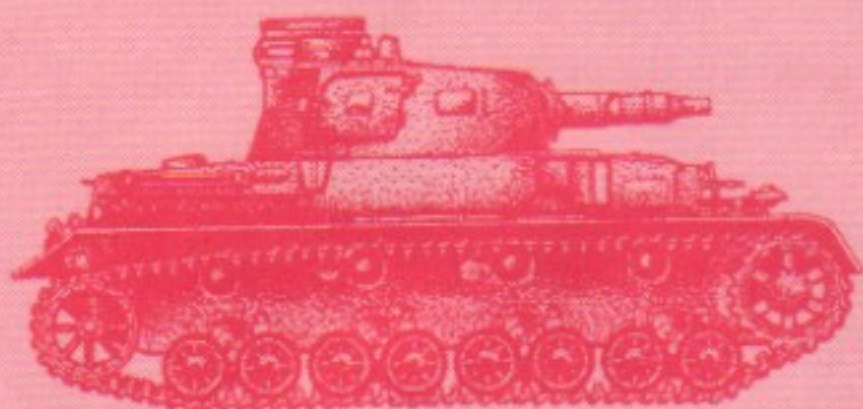
Your *STALINGRAD* package should contain:

- Registration Card

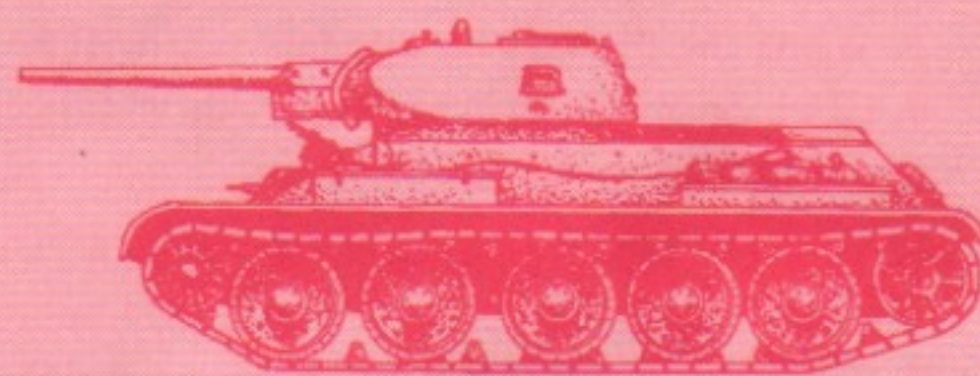
Minimum Requirements:

- 8MB RAM
- Hard Drive space with 7+ MB free
- 3½" HD Floppy Drive
- System v7.0 or higher
- 14" 256-Color Graphics Monitor

To Install *STALINGRAD*

STALINGRAD includes an Installation program which decompresses the data from the diskettes supplied with the game and transfers it to your hard drive. *STALINGRAD* must be installed on your hard drive before you can begin play.

1. Make sure you have *at least 7MB* of free disk space on your hard drive. For saving games, make sure additional HD space is available.
2. Put the disk labeled "**STALINGRAD Disk 1**" into your floppy disk drive.
3. Double click on the *STALINGRAD* disk icon.
4. Double click on the "STALINGRAD.SEA.1" icon.
5. When the dialog box appears, you will be prompted to "Load the FINAL segment of the archive".
6. Click on the EJECT button to remove the disk.
7. Put the disk labeled "**STALINGRAD Disk 2**" into your floppy disk drive.
8. Click on the LOAD button in the dialog box when it appears. Re-insert disk #1, then disk #2 again if your computer prompts you too (Some computers will skip the second part of this step).
9. You will now be prompted to select a "Destination Folder". Click on the DESKTOP button in the dialog box.
10. Click on the EXTRACT button in the dialog box to begin decompressing the files.
11. Disk #2 will now be ejected and you will be prompted to re-insert "**STALINGRAD Disk 1**". Extraction will begin.
12. These steps will create a folder on the Desktop containing the *STALINGRAD* files.
13. After extracting the files from disk #1 you will be prompted to re-insert disk #2 again.
14. You will then be prompted to re-insert disk #1 again.
15. When the extraction is completed click and drag the disk icons into the trashcan.
16. Click and drag the *STALINGRAD* folder from your desktop onto your HD icon to complete the extraction process.
17. You are now ready to begin playing *STALINGRAD* !!!!

Installing From a CD-ROM

If you own the CD-ROM version of *STALINGRAD*, you can only install the game to your hard drive.

To install *STALINGRAD* to the hard drive:

1. Place the CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive.
2. Double click on the *STALINGRAD* disk icon.
3. When the dialog box appears you will be prompted to "Load the FINAL segment of the archive".
4. Click on the LOAD button in the dialog box when it appears.
5. Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the installation.
6. You will now be prompted to select a "Destination Folder". Click on the DESKTOP button in the dialog box.
7. Then simply click on the EXTRACT button in the dialog box to begin decompressing the files.
8. These steps will create a folder on the Desktop containing the *STALINGRAD* files.
9. When the extraction is completed click and drag the disk icon into the trashcan.
10. Click and drag the *STALINGRAD* folder from your desktop to your HD icon to complete extraction.
11. You are now ready to begin playing *STALINGRAD* !!!!

Troubleshooting

Below are some possible conflicts and problems that you may encounter when trying to start up *STALINGRAD*. If you still encounter problems please don't hesitate to call the Avalon Hill Technical Support Department at (410) 426-9600, 8:30AM-5:00PM EST, Monday-Friday.

PROBLEM: I have a monitor larger than 14" and when the game starts up I receive a "Out of Memory" message.

SOLUTION: On monitors larger than 14" you must allocate more memory to *STALINGRAD*. Click once on the *STALINGRAD* icon and select the Get Info from the FILE pulldown menu and then adjust the preferred size to anywhere between 4500k and 5000k.

PROBLEM: If you encounter problems while loading *STALINGRAD* or getting the game to execute properly.

SOLUTION: Try restarting your system with the extensions turned off by holding down the SHIFT key during the rebooting process.
