



SYSTEM INFORMATION AND MANUAL ADDENDUM

MACINTOSH VERSION

HARDWARE REQUIRED

Macintosh Plus, Portable, PowerBook Family, SE, SE/30, Classic Family, LCII, II Family, Quadra Family

Black and white version requires 1 MB of RAM, 1.5 MB under System 7; color version requires 2 MB of RAM, 2.5 MB under System 7

Hard drive required

SOFTWARE REQUIRED

System 6.0.5 or later. System 7 compatible

AMIGA VERSION

HARDWARE REQUIRED

Amiga A500, A600, A1000, A2000, A2500, A3000, A4000 in NTSC or PAL

Requires 1 MB RAM for low-resolution; 1 MB RAM plus 512K Fast RAM for high-resolution

Two floppy drives or hard drive recommended

Printer option

SOFTWARE REQUIRED

Requires Workbench 1.3 or later. Release 2.0 compatible



INSTALLING MACINTOSH A-TRAIN

To install the black and white version of A-Train, create an A-Train folder on your hard drive. Drag the A-Train icon and the "ATrainB&W.res" icon from A-Train Disk 1 to the folder. To install the color version, drag the A-Train icon from Disk 1 and the "ATraincolor.res" icon on A-Train Disk 2 to the folder. Double-clicking on your A-Train program icon will load the application.

INSTALLING AMIGA A-TRAIN

Double-click on the "Install A-Train" icon on A-Train Disk 1. The installation program gives you three choices—Novice, Intermediate, and Expert. Novice provides a fully automated default installation on your hard drive, Intermediate allows you to direct the application's storage, and Expert gives you full control over every step of file creation and storage. See the Installer Help screens for more details. To install a printer driver on a floppy, double-click on "Install Printer" in the Utilities drawer on A-Train Disk 1.

If you intend to print the A-Train map landscapes, be sure to correctly set up your machine's Preferences for printing. Under KickStart 1.3 or earlier, you must use the Preferences program for setup. Under Release 2.0 or later, you must use both the Printer and PrinterGfx Preferences programs found in the Prefs drawer. You can get clarification of these procedures by reading "Using the System Software" in your Amiga manual.



MANUAL GRAPHICS

The graphics shown in the manual are gray-scaled renderings from the color Macintosh version of the program. Users with monochrome systems won't be able to see the color-coding of trains and train numbers on the "calendar chart" in the Train Registry, as well as some other color-issue incidentals, but gameplay won't be affected.

Command-Q	Quit
Command-G	Game Speed
Arrow Keys	Scroll Map Slightly, Scroll a List
Shifted Arrow Keys	Scroll Map or List One Page
Home	Scroll List to Top
End	Scroll List to Bottom
Page Up/Down	Scroll List One Page
Esc/Space Bar	Abort Track Laying
